Because the LSOKA is standardized, it ensures that everyone who wants to be considered for the LSO position receives a fair and objective opportunity. This test has been professionally validated to ensure job-relatedness. The LSOKA is a multiple choice test that contains questions assessing your knowledge in a wide range of subject matter related to technical knowledge, processes, procedures and standards.

The LSOKA is an online, proctored test that has 60 multiple choice questions measuring knowledge of technical processes, procedures and standards as related to the Lead System Operator job.
