“Based on our updated 2021 PSPS Protocols, some of the circuits below would not have been de-energized three or more times in any calendar year from 2019 to 2022. These circuits are noted below as ‘mitigated with PSPS Protocols’.”

Please explain in detail how circuit ID 152481106 (circuit name Brunswick 1106) would have been mitigated by PSPS Protocols.
