Members of the Diablo Canyon Decommissioning Engagement Panel (DCDEP) and Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) invite members of the communities surrounding Diablo Canyon Power Plant (DCPP) to submit an application to join the DCDEP focused on the future closure and decommissioning of DCPP.

The DCDEP is a volunteer, non-regulatory body focused on enhancing and fostering open communication, public involvement, and education on DCPP decommissioning plans and activities (Charter is limited to decommissioning activities only). It is intended to serve as a forum for local community members to provide direct input to PG&E, and inform regulatory agencies and other stakeholders on matters related to the eventual decommissioning of DCPP. Panel members work directly with PG&E representatives and other key community stakeholders.

DCDEP public meetings and workshops occur regularly and are moderated by the DCDEP's facilitator, Chuck Anders. There are monthly administrative meetings and other duties of the DCDEP. Volunteers should expect to serve 50 hours during the course of an average year.

PG&E will provide site-specifc training and educational opportunities for new members so they are knowledgeable and prepared to engage on DCPP decommissioning-related topics in public venues.

PANEL MEMBERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO:

- Participate openly and honestly in panel activities for effective two-way communication between the community and PG&E on issues associated with DCPP decommissioning planning.
- Be informed about community views on DCPP decommissioning issues so that they can provide both individual views and, where possible, the range of collective views for the stakeholder groups of which they are aware.
- groups and the general community, where appropriate, and seek their input to ensure that a diverse range of views are communicated to PG&E.
- Provide input and advice on the information exchange and communication between PG&E, stakeholder groups and the general community.
- Provide input on elements of the decommissioning planning process.
- Help to provide information to and feedback from stakeholder

Elected officials may serve as Ex-Officio members. PG&E employees and their immediate family members are not eligible for participation on the DCDEP, but are able to participate by attending public meetings.

The selection committee is comprised of PG&E representatives, a California Public Utilities Commission representative and current DCDEP members who will review applications and select community members to serve on the DCDEP for a specific term.

Applicants will be informed of the Committee's selections within 30 days of the submission deadline.
