Subject: Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Submission in response to Wildfire Safety Division (WSD) Geographic Information System (GIS) Data Standard for California Electrical Corporations – V2

Dear Ms. Jacobs:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) submits today an attached Status Report and GIS data files as required by the *Wildfire Safety Division's (WSD) Geographic Information System (GIS) Data Standard for California Electrical Corporations – V2*, issued on February 4, 2021. This submission (collectively referred to as “GIS Data Standard submission”) includes the data and information required in Conditional Guidance-10 for PG&E's 2020 Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP).

PG&E described in detail its GIS Data Standard submission through the narrative supporting Conditional Guidance-10. As noted in the response to Condition Guidance-10, PG&E has made significant effort to quantitatively improve our fourth quarterly submission (Q1 2021) and will continue to seek ways to enhance future submissions. Enhancement opportunities will largely require more involved operational and technological changes, including a significant level of resources required to collect, curate, and organize the Draft GIS Data Standard submissions on a recurring basis, while simultaneously advancing our data maturity. PG&E looks forward to continued conversation and collaboration with the WSD and other stakeholders on the GIS Data Standards.
