Subject: Elimination of Obsolete Street Light Contracts

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing revisions to its electric tariffs. The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.

Purpose

In compliance with the 2003 GRC Settlement and Decision (D.) 05-11-005, PG&E proposes to remove from its list of Contracts, certain street light agreements under the current Street and Outdoor Lighting Tariffs which are obsolete and have been superseded.

The three forms to be removed are:

Form 62-4510 - Agreement for Street and Highway Lighting (Overhead Service) Supplied From Distribution Lines of Pacific Gas and Electric Company

Form 62-4509 - Agreement For Street and Highway Lighting Customer-owned Electrolier Systems

Form 62-4908 - Agreement for Outdoor Area Lighting

The revisions resulting from the 2003 GRC Settlement included the creation of two Forms, 79-1007 - Request to Install or Energize Street Light Schedules LS-1 LS-2 and OL-1, and 79-1008 - Request to De-energize or Remove Street Light Schedules LS-1 LS-2 and OL-1, which supersede the Forms listed above, for installation and removal of lamps or services. These Forms were filed in Advice 2791-E on February 24, 2006, and approved on March 29, 2006.

This filing will not increase any rate of charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedule or rule.

Protests

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by sending a letter by **April 23**, **2007**, which is 20 days from the date of this filing.
