### Working to create a more environmentally responsible electric system

For the health and safety of our customers, employees and the environment, Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) Tower Coating Program is working to coat all lead-based painted electric transmission towers throughout our service territory with non-lead-based paint.

As part of this program, we reviewed nearly 46,000 transmission towers across our service territory to determine the coating type and identified approximately 6,000 towers with lead-based paint. We are coating those towers that use lead-based paint with a non-lead-based paint to make our towers safer for our communities.

### What to Expect

We want our customers to be fully informed about this work. **Important details include:**

- ✓ **This work will not affect electric service** in any way.
- ✓ **Safety measures will be in place** at all times, including all applicable COVID-19 precautions.
- ✓ Work will be completed by **trained crews using specialized equipment**.
- ✓ **Residents will not need to be present** during this work.
- ✓ Each tower will take approximately **three to five days** to coat.

We will coordinate with property owners to plan for this work and minimize any inconvenience or disruption. From cleaner energy to safer paint, our focus is on doing what's right for the communities we are proud to serve.
