ANSWER 01

Based on the clarifications provided in the preface to the data request, PG&E understands that this request covers the period from January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022. PG&E further understands that this request concerns formal submissions, for example the 2022 Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP) and quarterly submissions, provided to the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety).

With the exception of confidential and spatial data, PG&E posts annual and quarterly WMP submissions to our website, www.pge.com/wildfiremitigationplan, on the same business day that they are provided to Energy Safety. All submissions to Energy Safety are also posted to the appropriate docket on the Energy Safety Website, <https://efiling.energysafety.ca.gov/>, and email notifications are sent to those who subscribe to those dockets. If any of these submissions in 2022 contain confidential or spatial material that is not available through either of these two public websites, PG&E will be happy to provide those materials to the Public Advocates Office upon request.
