First we need to remove the old transformer and demo the existing concrete pad that we have here. This job is difficult because

being in residential areas has a lot of restrictions, especially with moving the heavy equipments, heavy trucks.

The new transformer was shipped from Korea to Long Beach, and then transported on the highway from Long Beach to Monterey.

It involves a lot of people to make this happen.
