We were celebrating the completion of a major upgrade at the Hollister substation, which is going to bring an enormous amount of capacity to fuel economic growth here locally. And it's been a four-year project to get it online and we're super excited to have it completed.

[POWER DRILL WHIRRING]

We have seen that this is a very active community, very fast growing, and they needed more capacity. And so this added substation bank is going to add 20 megawatts of capacity. It's a \$12 million project. We're really happy and excited to deliver it for our customers in Hollister.

[FRICTION NOISE]

That substation, we replaced a 25 MVA bank with a 45 MVA bank, so adding about 20 megawatts of capacity. And additionally, there was a new circuit that was built leading from the substation out to the airport here in Hollister, which is kind of where most of the economic growth is happening locally.

Hollister is primarily always been a bedroom community to the Silicon Valley. So there's been a lot of people who live here, who commute to the Silicon Valley. But what the city and the county are hoping for is that this additional electric capacity will enable businesses to move here and develop and keep jobs here locally.

We're investing in projects like this all across our service area to keep up with the demand that we're seeing in our communities. We want to be sure that we are enabling the economic and community vitality of all the hometowns that we serve.
