



Disability Disaster Access & Resource Program (DDAR)

Supporting you during wildfire safety outages

PG&E partners with the California Foundation for Independent Living Centers (CFILC) to support older adults and people with disabilities and chronic medical conditions before, during and after wildfire safety outages.

DDAR helps people with medical and independent living needs:

- ✓ Create an emergency plan
- ✓ Sign up for the Medical Baseline (MBL) Program
- ✓ Apply for backup power
- ✓ Receive food replacement
- ✓ Find ADA-accessible car rides and hotel stays



DDAR Program Eligibility

To qualify, a customer must live in a High Fire-Threat District* or have experienced two or more PSPS events since 2020. A customer must also meet one of the following:

- Use an electrical medical device or assistive technology
- Have a disability or chronic condition
- Rely on electricity to live independently

The CFILC determines qualifications for backup batteries and other resources. A doctor is not needed to verify disability or condition. Customers are encouraged to reach out to their local DDAR Center before a safety outage.
