I work in the field. I work with electricity every day, so I get to deal with this stuff every day. I get to see some of the dangers that I get to explain to people.

I'm coming out here, and I'm talking about calling 811 before you dig.

We have a demonstration with the man on a metal ladder. Some of the dangers are, don't use metal ladders around energized equipment, and then it will actually blow a little fuse up. We have a wheel with several questions on it, so there are 811, PG&E environment, general PG&E questions. Customers come up, or the people come up, they spin the wheel.

I do about 20 events per year. We go to the schools. Children enjoy doing that, when they find the one that says you're a winner, and we clap.

Giving back to the community is something that I enjoy doing. There's people that will come up to me that are much older than I am, and they'll say, I remember seeing this same thing as a kid. And then they'll bring their kids.
