

**POSTING REQUIREMENTS FOR FERC STANDARDS OF CONDUCT
PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY**

FERC Standards of Conduct, Section 358.7(a): If a transmission provider discloses non-public transmission function information, other than information identified in paragraph (a)(2) of this section, in a manner contrary to the requirements of § 358.6, the transmission provider must immediately post the information that was disclosed on its Internet website.

In preparation for a potential Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) event that is forecasted to commence the morning of 09/30/2024, on 09/29/2024 Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) notified potentially affected customers that the transmission lines identified below may be de-energized during the PSPS event.

Transmission Lines that may be de-energized:

Pit #4	230 KV
Elk Creek Tap	60 KV
Pit #6	230 KV
Cascade-Benton-Deschutes	60 KV
Kilarc-Cedar Creek	60 KV
